

Regulation on Curriculum Development and Review

Article 1

Scope of the Regulation on Curriculum Development and Review is provided to deal with the permanent development and continuous revision of curricula.

Article 2

Curriculum development and revision is done for the operating departments in Biznesi College. Each department, faculty has the obligation to provide data and new contemporary methodologies of curriculum developments as well as to supervise their implementation.

Article 3

The curricula must be in full compliance with current contemporary developments in the scientific field for the College in certain fields of Economics, Emergency and Law.

Article 4

Each Department/Faculty holds at least two meetings during the academic year and as needed.

Article 5

5.1 The Commission for Development and Review of Curricula is established by HTSC

5.2. A Special Commission is established for the Development and Review of Curricula

5.3. The members of the Commission hold the rank of professor and should reflect the areas of study development and the level of studies.

Article 6

Composition of the commission

6.1.The commission consists of six professors with the highest scientific degree and two students, one student must represent the basic studies and one will represent the postgraduate students.

6.2. Commission oversees the implementation of teaching curricula

6.3. The commission proposes and recommends changes in the curriculum

6.3. The commission provides information towards new developments in the respective fields of study

6.4. The commission may oblige to change certain curricula

Article 7

7.1 The commission will review the teaching curricula for each academic year

7.2. The commission will also propose adequate training for new staff in curriculum design

7.3. The commission provides written opinions about the curricula set for certain programs.

Article 8

The commission provides scientific advice and methodology on curriculum content.

Article 9

The commission holds meetings for certain departments according to the needs of the departments.

Article 10

The commission meets before the beginning of the academic year.

Article 11

The commission also provides additional data, details and good practices in the development and maintenance of teaching curricula.
