Office for Quality Assurance of "Business" College I. In general for the measurement of the quality and the history of the realization of the questionnaires bachelor students - winter semester

College "Business" (hereinafter: COLLEGES "BUSINESS"), as an Institution of Higher Education (Hereinafter: HEI) established since 2004, has constantly made efforts to make measurable quality assurance process. For every year at the end of each semester (2 times a year), at COLLEGES "BUSINESS" questionnaires were organized with students and other relevant actors, who responded in the questions which were intended to show accurately the real situation in the BUSINESS COLLEGE through respondents' perceptions.

BUSINESS COLLEGE has its own mechanisms for measuring quality, and in addition to the process being measured and is continuously monitored by the dean, vice dean, quality coordinators within College, the Office of Quality Assurance of the College "Business" (hereinafter: IPSAS) has a role of special in these developments, and is the main body within the BUSINESS COLLEGE for measuring interior quality.

In January 2021, in the wake of activities to improve quality within the COLLEGE "BUSINESS", in order to improve the provision of services in "BUSINESS" COLLEGE, improving teaching as an ever-changing process in terms of new methodologies, and increasing the responsibility of the management staff, OCCKB has realized questionnaire with the students of "BUSINESS" COLLEGE, at the Bachelor level, at the end of the semester winter, as an already common process. The whole process of designing questionnaires, placing them (launching) and collecting data is made by ZSCKB. The process has been transparent, and all questionnaires have been unanimous thus, respecting the dignity of each respondent and maintaining the prestige of the institution.

Below, we will present the data extracted from the questionnaires. In order for the report to save ethics of each and that of the institution, you will find published the answers summarized by the findings of each question extracted from the questionnaires and which are included in the following report summary. The recommendations, as the last part of it, will also contain suggestions and remarks

which are not made public here, but which are provided by the respondents.

1. The progress of the questionnaire

The questionnaire for students was drafted in January 2021, at the end of the winter semester, by on the part of ZSCKB, is intended to include all bachelor's students of all programs of "BUSINESS" COLLEGE. 392 students of who have completed 1915 questionnaires for 5 programs, 4 of the third year and 1 of the fourth year, they answered for each of their subjects, as well as for each professor. This questionnaire has been anonymous.

The questionnaire contained 22 questions with alternatives and that 12 questions for the teacher and 10 questions

for the subject, with only one choice, and there were 3 open questions for suggestions and remarks as well as free comments. The IPSASB has processed the results in the summary table and the graph is generated automatically. The questions were meant to see these main aspects:

- Teachers' approach to students;
- Teaching methods;
- Student space during the lesson;
- Teacher behavior;
- Learning Outcomes.

2. Findings from the questionnaire

Student participation in questionnaires is considered satisfactory. Students have not hesitated to answer, and did not give selective answers to some questions, and avoid other questions. Also, from the comments they gave in the open question section, it was noticed that the students are interested in contributing to the processes in "BUSINESS" COLLEGE, and are clear in their judgment.

This report expresses only general statistics, and recommendations arising from the entirety of answers. Whereas, the reports for the faculties separately, as well as for each professor, ZSCKB has sent to the Dean, and he will discuss their findings with his academic staff.

The main findings, in some of the specific questions and areas, from the questionnaire conducted with the students, consist as follows:




To the question of how clear the Teacher is in lectures, students answer differently


